# RESOLUTION NO. 1311 PORT OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF BELLINGHAM PROPOSING THAT TWO COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS INCLUDE THE ENTIRE PORT DISTRICT IN THE EVENT THE NUMBER OF PORT COMMISSIONERS IS INCREASED FROM THREE (3) COMMISSIONERS TO FIVE (5) COMMISSIONERS.

**WHEREAS**, the laws of the State of Washington, RCW 53.12.010, authorized the Port Commission of the Port of Bellingham to resolve that a ballot proposition be submitted to the qualified voters of the Port District to determine whether two of the Commissioner Districts may include the entire Port District if the voters approve the increase in the number of Commissioners to five (5) members.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Port Commission of the Port of Bellingham, Whatcom County, Washington as follows:

**Section 1.** Finding. The Port Commission determines that it shall submit a proposition for voter approval or rejection at the district general election to be held on November 6, 2012, that, in the event the number of Commissioners for the Port of Bellingham is approved by the voters to be increased from three (3) Commissioners to five (5) Commissioners, whether the two (2) additional Commissioners shall be elected from district-wide (the entire Port District) Commissioner Districts. The Port Commission further determines that this issue should be decided at the general election to be held on November 6, 2012 because it is anticipated that the general election to be held on November 6, 2012 will have the greatest voter turnout.

**Section 2.** Authorization For Election. The Whatcom County Auditor, as exofficio supervisor of elections in Whatcom County, is hereby requested to find and to call and conduct such election within the Port District on such day and to submit to the qualified electors of the Port District for their approval or rejection at the general election to be held on November 6, 2012, a proposition that, in the event the number of Commissioners for the Port of Bellingham is approved by the voters to be increased from three (3) to five (5), whether the two (2) additional Commissioners shall be elected from district-wide Commissioner Districts.

**Section 3.** Approval of Form of Ballot Proposition. The Secretary of the Port of Bellingham is hereby authorized and directed to certify said proposition to the Auditor of Whatcom County, State of Washington, in the following form to be placed on the ballot for the 2012 general election in that form or substantially similar as to properly place the proposition before the qualified voters:
