This form is not a completed application without payment. If submitting by mail, please include a check. If submitting electronically, harbor staff will contact you for payment.

Applicants are responsible for keeping the Port advised of their current mailing address, telephone number, and email address.

Each application for the waiting list will be assessed a \$100.00 non-refundable fee. After the initial application fee, an annual fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each application to remain on the waiting list. Fees collected are not applied towards future moorage. If the fee is not paid the applicant will be removed from the waiting list and will need to complete a new Waiting List Application to get back on the list.

It is the Port's policy to process the waiting list by date of application, with the earliest date receiving first consideration. Moorage is assigned in that order with consideration given to the overall length, beam, and operating characteristics of the vessel. Applicant will be removed from the list if slip offer is declined or if applicant does not respond within given timeframe. Customers may amend their request or be removed from the list at any time, this must be done in writing.

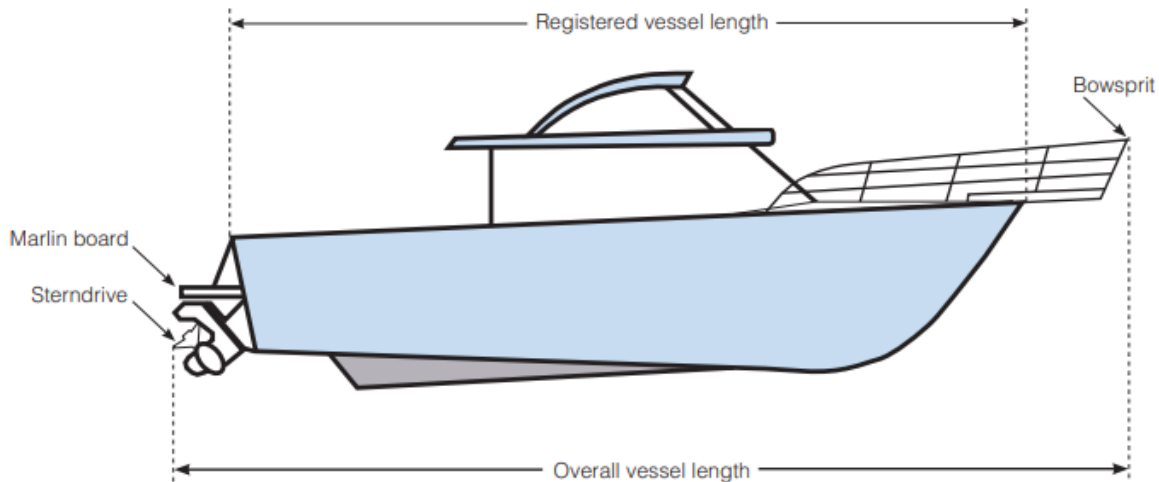

Blaine Harbor Recreational Moorage Waiting List Addendum

- ☐ I understand that the vessel to be moored at Blaine Harbor must be navigable in open water under its own power.
- ☐ I understand that upon accepting a moorage offer, I will need to provide a copy of the vessel registration and proof of insurance, that meets the Port's requirements in the applicant's name, prior to moving the boat into Blaine Harbor.
- ☐ I understand Blaine Harbor does not allow for any overhang from slips and that the length overall (LOA) to be moored must fit entirely within the slip. I also understand that if my vessel is too large for the slip that is offered I may be forced to forfeit my offer of moorage and my spot on the waitlist. Length overall (LOA) of a vessel is the maximum length of the hull measured in a straight line, from the foremost to the aftermost point, including any parts of the hull and equipment that extend beyond the waterline.



The applicant understands these rules and agrees to abide by these, as well as those set forth in the Port of Bellingham's *Harbors' Rules, Regulations, and Rates Handbook*.
