Steve Swan gave an update on WWU's program planning. Western remains committed to placing Huxley College of the Environment and the College of Business and Economics or some hybrid of the two at the waterfront. However, in looking at the economic climate right now, constructing new buildings of significant size is not realistic. WWU is studying the possibility of building a smaller facility that can be expanded when funds become available. Western is focusing on building a "community learning center" that meets the needs of the community and the campus, the latter with a focus on high tech delivery for undergraduate, graduate and extended education programs. The facility would also meet Western's needs for presentation space and provide a venue to host special programs and outreach events that showcase the expertise of students, faculty and staff.
